## Update: Covid 19 and the provision of elective surgical procedures

Dear Fellows,

Following the Prime Minister's meeting with National Cabinet yesterday, Friday 15 May 2020, it was agreed to reopen elective surgery by removing restrictions and restoring hospital activity across 3 temporal stages. His media statement advised that it will be a decision of each jurisdiction to determine which stage applies to its circumstances, the timeline for implementation and that the level of normal surgical activity is safely restored in line with agreed principles. I wish you, your families and your staff continued good health at this time and hope that we can all look forward to a gradual return to normal in coming months.
